SAYULITA RESTAURANTS

- ★ **1. Burrito Revolution** — Super good burritos!
- ★ **2. Cafe El Espresso** — Coffee is the best, decent breakfast, and nice location at the plaza.
- ★ **3. Don Padros** — Always good and a great beach location. Try the Margarita pizza or the beet ravioli. Everything on the menu is consistently good. Sea food and meat are fresh and well prepared.
- ★ **4. BreakFast** — A great breakfast.
- ★ **5. Los Afortunados** — Nice ambiance, good food, unusual and tasty ice cream.
- ★ **6. Mary's** — Good Mexican food, all day long.
- ★ **7. Naty's Tacos** — We could eat her food all day long. Clean, fast, and delicious food at the best price in all of Sayulita. She always has something vegetarian.
- ★ **8. Orangy's Juice Bar** — This is a friendly, fun, fresh juice bar full of local color. Owners Danni and Paul, from Mexico City and Leeds, England, make you feel right at home. They'll fix you up with the best juice in Sayulita. They use purified water and wash everything in "the drops."
- ★ **9. Ruben's Deli** — Best sandwiches in town, they could be the best we've ever had.
- ★ **10. Sayulita Café** — A favorite spot. Authentic Mexican dinners. Great food, drinks and service.
- ★ **11. The Real Fish Taco** — Look for the yellow sign and street tables with stools. Delicious, fresh tacos!
- ★ **12. Tierra Viva** — Just down the hill from Dreamer's Circle, this restaurant has become our most frequented dining spot. Breakfast, yummy. Dinner, great salads and daily specials. We love this place.
- ★ **13. Villa Amor** — A beautiful location and for dinner, a very romantic setting right at the water's edge. Service is slow, so order first and have a drink. You won't be disappointed.

SAYULITA GROCERIES

There are many mom and pop food markets in town. If you are buying milk, be sure to check the date. Most stores have liquor, beer and soda.

- ★ **14. Best Fresh Produce** — If you want to take a walk for fresh produce and the widest variety of fruits and veggies, walk down town, past the plaza, over the bridge, and walk another block. On the right is a small shop with tables of produce in front. You can also buy from the trucks around town.
- ★ **15. Don Rodolfo** — Produce, a little closer.
- ★ **16. Tranco's Carniceria** — Best quality butcher shop in town including deli items.

PRODUCE TIP: When you are in town, buy a bottle of "the drops." When you get home, soak all produce in the drop bath for 15-30 minutes. This can help you avoid ever getting sick.

SAYULITA BAKERIES & TREATS

- ★ **17. Casa Gourmet** — Fresh baked bread and good take out.
- ★ **18. Pannios** — Down near the beach, look for the green canopy. This is where you will find a very special treat. The bread is always fresh, just like bread we've had in Europe. But the sweets are what you want. Not too sweet, more like they are in France. They also make good sandwiches.
- ★ **19. Wakika Heladeria Ice Cream Parlor** — Family run with ice cream made in town, stop by one of their two locations for icy and oh-so-refreshing goodness. Wakika comes from Huichol, one of the native languages in Nayarit, México. In Spanish, it means "Las Olas" (The Waves).

SAYULITA SHOPPING & GALLERIES

Just walking around down town, you will find many fun and exciting shops. Here's some we really like.

- ★ **20. Cori Jacobs Gallery** — Gallery of said artist. Painting, ceramics and textile.
- ★ **21. Esto Es Mexico** — Popular trinket shop.
- ★ **22. La Hamaca Gallery** — Beautiful fine arts and crafts from all over Mexico.
- ★ **23. Oaxaca Rug Store** — Francisco and his family hand make all the rugs, with vegetable dyes, in this wonderful little shop. Great prices, just past Sayulita Cafe.
- ★ **24. The Gypsy Gallery** — We always find something in this shop, a gift for a friend, something for the house, etc. It is overflowing with Mexican crafts, clothing, paintings, pottery, jewelry, and much more.
- ★ **25. Victoriano, Sayulita's talented painter** — Most of the wall art in our home was purchased from Victoriano. He is down by the river, just past and next to the bridge (on the ocean side). He sets up his easel and works in the shade of the trees. He doesn't speak much English but he understands quite well. After you find a painting you like, he will remove it from the frame and roll it up for you to take home.
